Information clause concerning the processing of personal data

Pursuant to Article 13(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2016/679 of the European Parliament and of the Council of April 27, 2016 on the protection of natural persons with regard to the processing of personal data and on the free movement of such data and repealing Directive 95/46/EC (General Data Protection Regulation), hereinafter referred to as 'RODO', we inform you that:

Personal data including: name, e-mail address, degree/title, title of the presentation and affiliation, mailing address will be processed for the following purposes:

- registration of participation, organization and publication of all submitted papers on the event page on the website of the Institute of Literature and Linguistic Studies of UJK in Kielce and Facebook.
- to communicate with Participants via e-mail in matters related to the conference, including acceptance of their registration and announcement of the conference programme.

Personal data in the form of image and name will be used for the following purposes: promotional, educational and popularization in social networks of the Institute of Literature and Linguistic Studies of UJK in Kielce in the case of consent to use the image.

Personal data will not be transferred outside the EEA (European Economic Area).

The provision of personal data in the registration form is voluntary; however, without providing such data it will not be possible to participate in the registration process and in the conference.

Your data may only be provided to entities authorized to process them under the law. We will also make your data available to entities acting on our behalf entitled to process them on the basis of a contract, i.e. processors such as: hosting service providers, entities providing services for the administrator's IT systems and software.

We will store your data for the period necessary to fulfil the purpose for which they were collected, i.e. the recruitment (registration) for the conference and the realization and organization of the conference, but also for archival purposes, where required by the provisions of the Act of July 14, 1983 on National Archive Resources and Archives (i.e. Journal of Laws 2020, item 164) - for a period of 5 years, counting from the date of completion of the conference evaluation process.

Under the terms of the RODO regulations, you have the right to:

- a. access to your data,
- b. to rectify (amend) your personal data,
- c. to restrict the processing of your personal data,
- d. erasure of your personal data,
- e. object to the processing.

A person whose personal data is processed by the Administrator has the right to withdraw consent to the processing of his/her personal data at any time to the extent that he/she has given such consent. However, the withdrawal of consent will not affect the processing that was carried out on the basis of that person's consent before its withdrawal.
